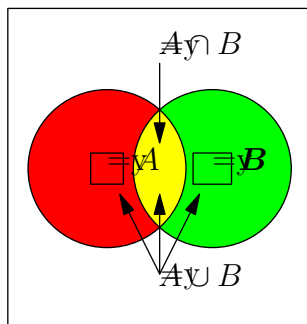
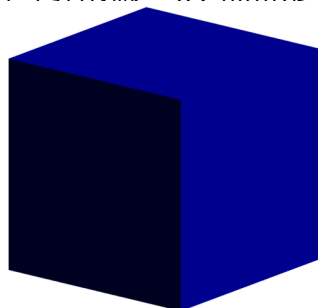


Here is a venn diagram produced with Asymptote, drawn to width 4cm:



Each graph is drawn in its own environment. One can specify the width and height to  $\LaTeX$  explicitly. This 3D example can be viewed interactively either with Adobe Reader or Asymptote's fast OpenGL-based renderer. To support `\letexmk`, 3D figures should specify `inline=true`. It is soon quiet
